WORKSHEET ON ADVANCEMENT TO CANDIDACY:

The requirements for advancement to candidacy are simple. You must have passed the comprehensive theory examinations at the Ph.D. level, you must satisfied all of your course requirements in your intended major and minor field (including minimum grade standards) as well as your supporting course requirement, and you must have satisfied the course requirement in econometrics. You must also have a plan to satisfy your workshop requirements. You do not need to have passed the field exam or paper requirement in your major field to advance to candidacy, although you will need to do this by the end of your third year to retain funding. We will process your advancement to candidacy once you have completed the following worksheet. There are additional requirements for finishing your PhD beyond what is required to advance to candidacy; you must complete the major field requirements, defend a dissertation proposal, complete and defend your final dissertation, and register for at least 12 credits of Doctoral Dissertation research (Econ 899).
